


Bibliographic Organizer

The Bibliographic Organizer is a tool to help you save information that will help you locate and access the sources you select at a later date. The information is saved from the Library of Congress Bibliographic Information Page related to each primary source you choose. An example entry and directions are included below.

<p><u>Image:</u> Use your keyboard to copy (Ctrl + C) the small thumbnail image. Paste (Ctrl + V) into the first column.</p> <p>OR from the menu bar, select “Save the image” to your desktop and then “Insert Image” to paste.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> If no thumbnail image is available, simply note the source format. (e.g. “Audio Recording”)</p>	<p><u>Title, Author, Date:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Copy and paste the exact Title of your primary source, • Author/Creator of the item, • and the Publication Date. 	<p><u>Digital ID and URL:</u> Copy and paste the Digital ID. Repeat to save the persistent URL.</p> <p><u>Note:</u> The persistent URL may be listed at the bottom of the information page. If not, use the URL shown in the address bar at the top of your screen.</p>
