The Bibliographic Organizer is a tool to help you save information that will help you locate and access the sources you select at a later date. The information is saved from the Library of Congress Bibliographic Information Page related to each primary source you choose. An example entry and directions are included below.

(e.g. "Audio Recording")  | ve  | Title, Author, Date:  Copy and paste the exact Title of your primary source, Author/Creator of the item, and the Publication Date. | Digital ID and URL: Copy and paste the Digital ID.
