Part II: Classroom Activity Plan

Goal: Students will examine drawings and share ideas about children's perceptions and reactions to tragic events.

This lesson will be a kick-off to a unit on historical fiction, i.e. - I SurvivedSeries.

Essential/Investigative Question:

How did children respond in the days following the attacks of September 11, 2001?

Objective(s):

• Students will investigate and analyze the drawings made by other students in response to the attacks of September 11, 2001.

Standard(s) Addressed:

Procedure:

- 1. Teacher will model analyzing a drawing or photograph.
- 2. Students will work in 4 groups of 5. Each group will be assigned one drawing.
- 3. Students will analyze their drawing and present their ideas to the class.
- 4. Class will offer input to each group and entertain discussion.
- 5. Teacher will introduce "I Survived" Series and link from drawings to unit on historical fiction.
