

STUDY ABROAD STUDENT GUIDE



STEP ONE: INFORM YOUR ADVISER OF YOUR INTENT TO STUDY ABROAD.



STEP TWO: GATHER INFORMATION ABOUT PROGRAM OPTIONS. WHERE WILL YOU GO? NARROW IT DOWN TO YOUR TOP THREE CHOICES.



STEP THREE: MEET WITH THE COORDINATOR OF STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS ON CAMPUS (EMAIL LISTED BELOW).



STEP FOUR: TALK TO FINANCIAL AID, BILLING & THE REGISTRAR'S OFFICE FOR MORE INFORMATION.



STEP FIVE: SUBMIT THE STUDY ABROAD APPLICATION ON MYCONNECT BEFORE MARCH 1. THIS IS THE DEADLINE FOR BOTH THE FALL AND SPRING SEMESTERS OF THE NEXT YEAR.

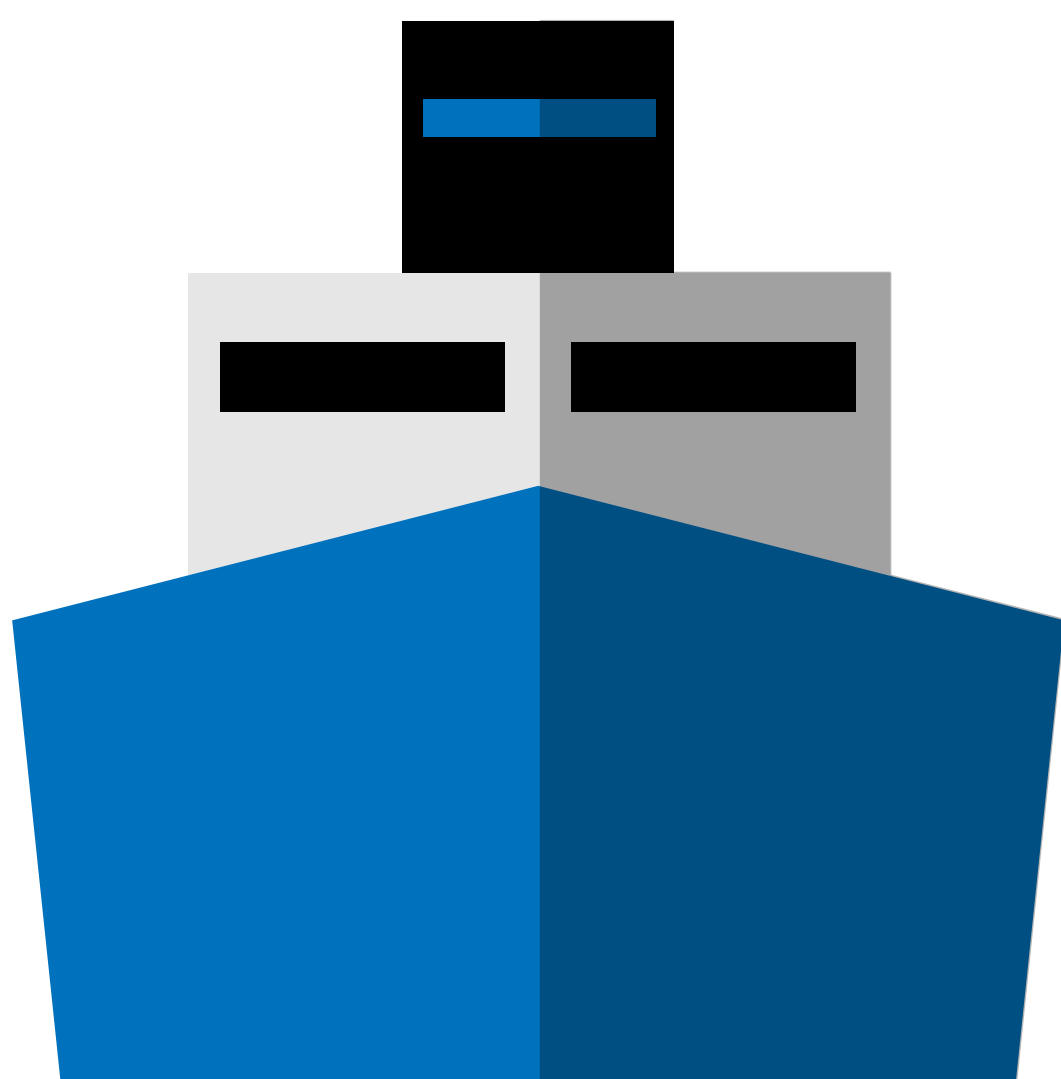
*YOU WILL SUBMIT A SEPARATE APPLICATION TO YOUR PROGRAM OF CHOICE.

SELECTION PROCESS

THOSE WHO INTEND TO TRAVEL INTERNATIONALLY AND SUBMIT A STUDY ABROAD APPLICATION BEFORE MARCH 1 WILL BE CONSIDERED TO APPLY ALL OF THEIR INSTITUTIONAL AID TO THEIR STUDY ABROAD EXPERIENCE. TEN STUDENTS WILL BE SELECTED TO TAKE INSTITUTIONAL AID WITH THEM.

INSTITUTIONAL AID IS THE FINANCIAL AID GRANTED TO STUDENTS FROM WAYNESBURG UNIVERSITY (IT'S NOT WHAT YOU RECEIVE FROM FAFSA - THAT'S FEDERAL AND STATE AID).

INSTITUTIONAL AID IS NOT AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS TRAVELING ON DOMESTIC PROGRAMS.
