

## How to Access TPS Eastern Region Courses Via Canvas


### 1. Set up Your Canvas Login at least 24 hours in advance:

- ✓ Once registered, you will receive an email directly from Canvas ([notifications@instructure.com](mailto:notifications@instructure.com)). The email will identify your name and email, as shown.
- ✓ Click **Get Started** and follow directions to set up your Password.

### 2. Check Your Email for Instructions to Confirm Your Canvas Login.

### 3. After Confirming:

- ✓ Navigate to <https://waynesburg.instructure.com/login/canvas> and login to access course tools and materials.
  - Canvas recommends you **DO NOT use Internet Explorer**.
    - PC: Use Chrome or FireFox
    - Apple/Mac: Use Safari 11 or 12 or Chrome
  - Mobile devices are compatible, but may not be optimal.
    - Chrome 6.0+ or Safari iOS 12.2+. **Canvas by Instructure app** is the mobile version of Canvas and is available for both iOS and Android devices.
- ✓ **NOTE:** BASICS course materials should be available immediately. PDPI course materials will be available one week prior to the first live session. If materials are not available, contact Sue Wise ([swise@waynesburg.edu](mailto:swise@waynesburg.edu)) for assistance.



### 4. Weekly Live Conferences (If your TPS course requires them):

#### At least 24 hours in advance:

- ✓ Plug the headset into your computer.
- ✓ Try out the Conference feature: <https://test.bigbluebutton.org/>.

#### When it's time to join, login to Canvas and:

- ✓ Select **Conferences** from the left menu.
- ✓ Select **Join** to enter the Conference.
- ✓ Choose **Microphone** and follow the on-screen directions.
 

**OR**, if the headset is unavailable, join using your phone and follow on-screen instructions. Webcams are not used.
- ✓ **If you need to miss a Live Conference session, contact your course facilitator. Session recordings are available for two weeks.**

### Additional Suggestions:

- ✓ Use a **wired internet connection** to avoid buffering delays. If you must use a wifi connection, place your device close to the router and ask others to refrain from downloading or viewing large files or videos during class.
