



Recording in Canvas Studio

➤ Purpose

This document will provide information on recording in Canvas Studio. You can record a video using your webcam in Canvas Studio. Videos can be recorded from any page in your account. You can record media for any length of time, but shorter video recordings under 5 minutes long are recommended due to browser resource limitations.

➤ Scope

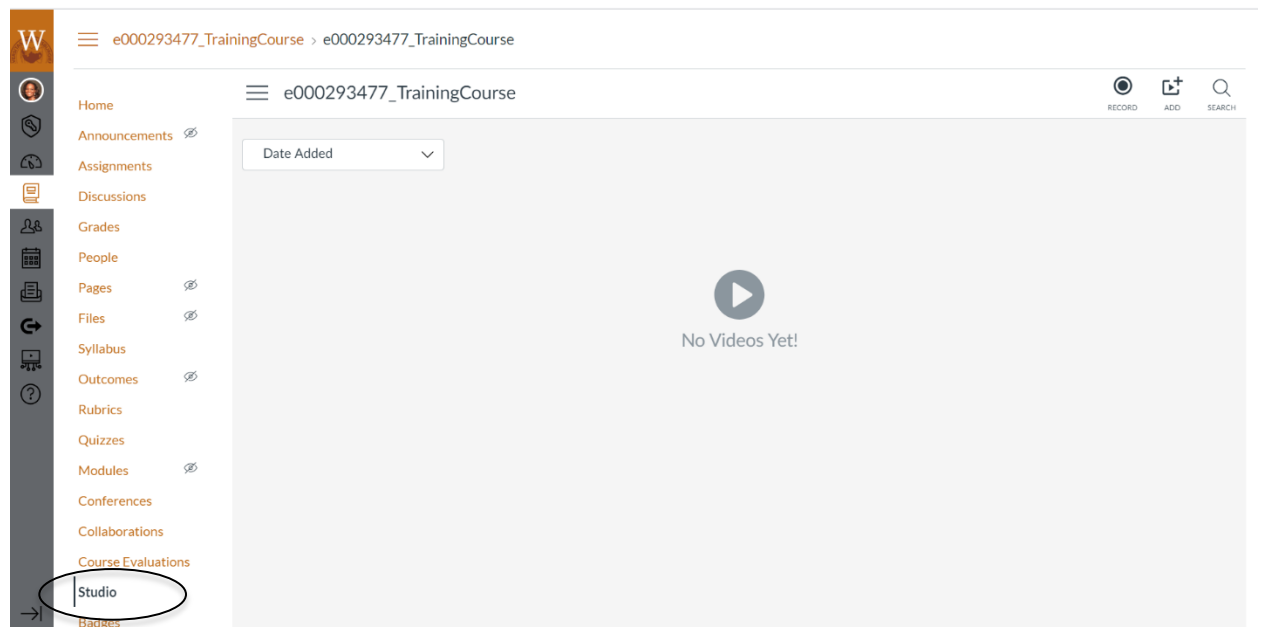
This document will provide faculty with instructions and suggestions for recording lectures in Canvas Studio.

➤ Background

Studio webcam capture is only supported by Chrome and Firefox browsers. If you use an unsupported browser, Studio will ask you to switch browsers.

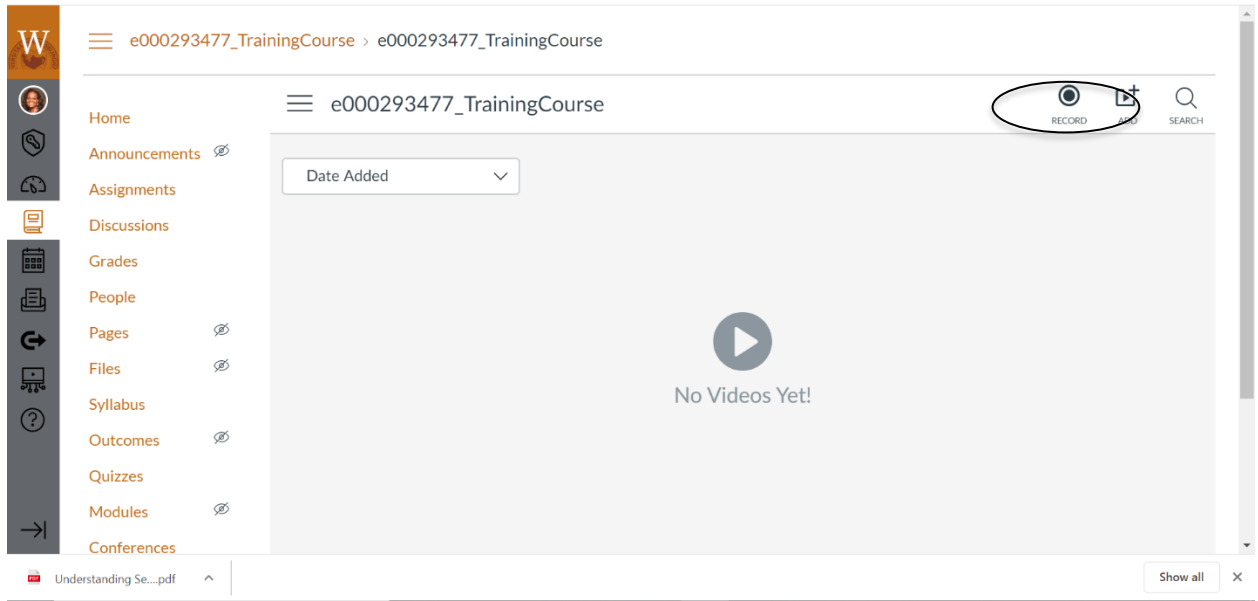
➤ Directions for Recording in Studio AND Sharing the recording

Go into the course and click on Studio

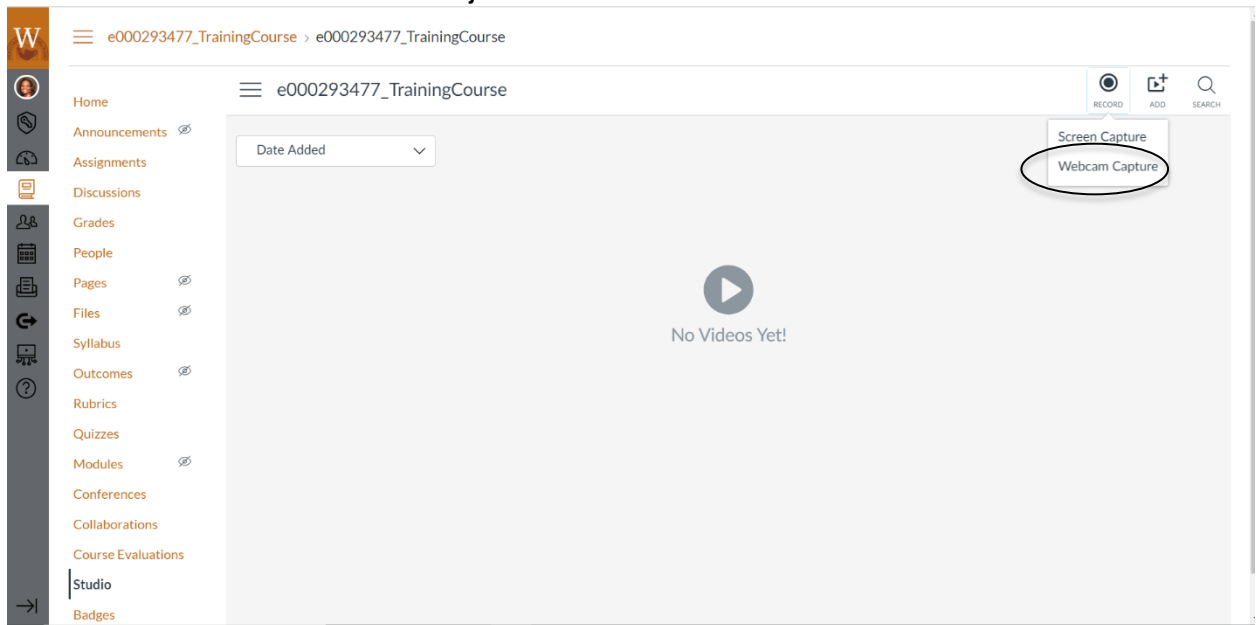




Next click the record button



You will have the option to use the Screen capture or Webcam capture. We will use the Webcam feature for this job aide





Start recording

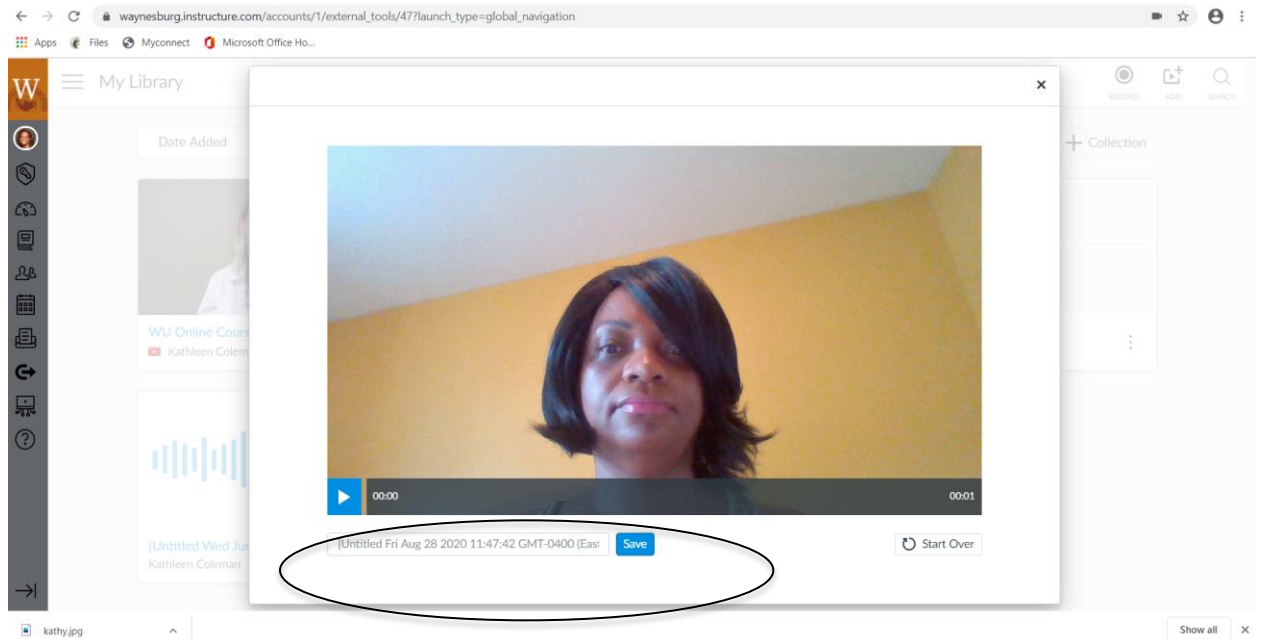

When done, click finish

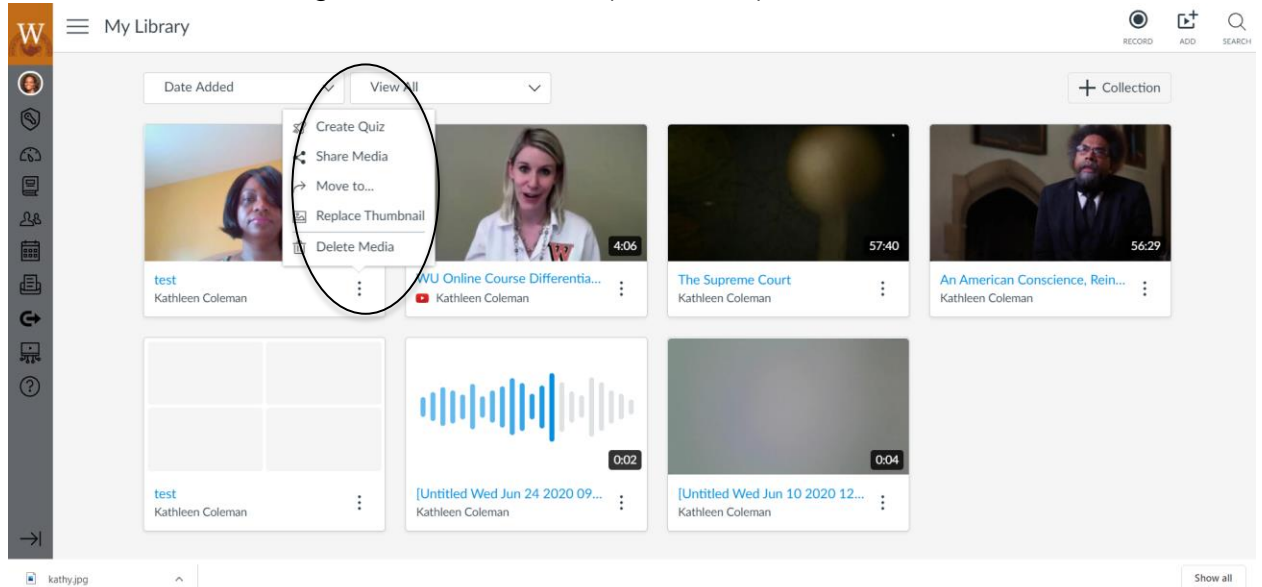

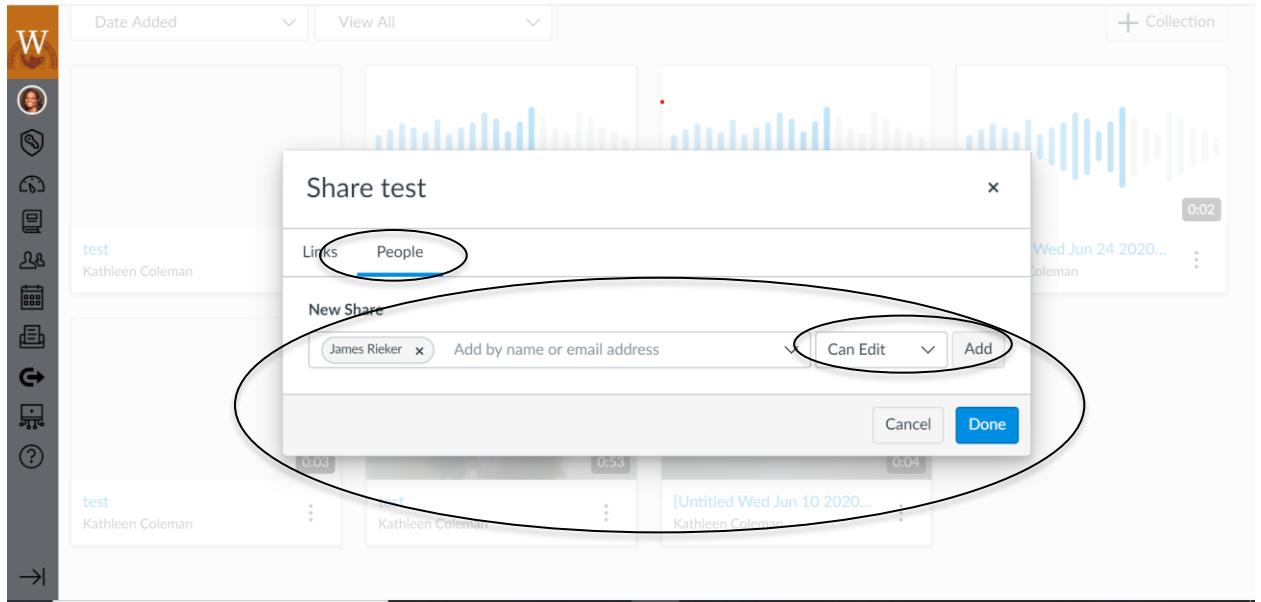
Name the recording and click save
