

ABOUT OUR SURVEY


- 2 county focus area (Greene, Washington)

*to increase our statistical power, our goal was to reach at least a 30% response rate


What best describes the areas of your nonprofit's services? Please check all that apply.



Typically how many people does your organization serve annually?




How far into the future have you strategized?




Approximately 60% have had to decrease their services provided since March.


Has your organization had to increase/decrease the services you provide as a result of Covid-19?



Has your organization had to make cuts in any of the following areas?




Those who have decreased services report needing the most help with strategic planning of fundraising, as well as greater losses in volunteers.




In terms of strategic planning needs, most want help with fundraising and developing partnerships (only half have connections to larger NPOs, for example).


Do you need assistance with strategic planning in any of the following areas? Please check all that apply.



Have you seen a decline in the number of volunteers since March?




The greatest source of lost revenue is from events, followed by both private and corporate donations.




They anticipate the greatest future losses coming from private and corporate donations, followed closely by local funding.


