Waynesburg University was recently notified that we will receive funding through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERFII), established under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA). Part of this fund has been designated for emergency grants to our students.

In reviewing the terms of the CRSAA, it appears that you meet the initial criteria to receive a grant. You must complete the grant application process described below in order to receive a grant. Grant amounts will vary based on financial need and number of applicants, and are expected to be between \$500 and \$1,000.

To qualify for CRRSAA grants, students must be a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen for federal aid purposes. While you are <u>NOT</u> required to have filed a Free Application for Federal Student (FAFSA), you are required to complete the CRRSAA Certification form (using URL below) attesting to your eligibility.

To receive the grant, you must complete the CRRSAA Certification form using the link below. On the form, you will attest that you meet the eligibility requirements and that you will use the grant funds in accordance with federal regulations. The form must be completed by February 22, 2021. You will have the opportunity to designate on the form whether you'd like the grant funds to be credited toward your student account balance or issued to you directly. Grant funds will be credited/issued after the deadline.
