Leia Watson Land Management Intern



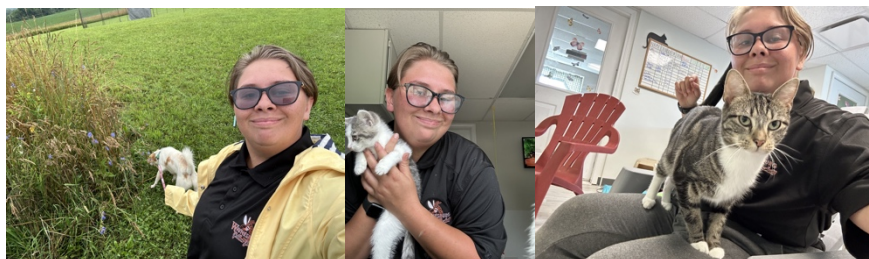
