Computer Recommendations:

- Waynesburg University strongly recommends all incoming students purchase a PC or Mac using the guidelines in the table on the following page.
- The estimated price range for a computer at or above the minimum specs is between \$800 - \$1500.
- The choice between PC and Mac is a personal preference. In most cases either platform will work well for students.
- Some departments or degree programs may have specific computer/software requirements. Students may contact their departments or program(s) for more information.

You may find it useful to have the following items available:

- External hard drive to back up your files and/or Cloud storage
- Portable charger/power bank
- USB flash drive

Computer Labs/Printing:

- Computer labs and printing stations are available across campus. Students can use their WU credentials to access a device.
- The locations of computer labs and printing stations are available on the ITS tab of myConnect.
- Students are permitted to bring a personal printer for their residence hall.

Campus Network Connectivity:

- Secure wireless and wired internet connectivity is available in all residence halls via Apogee ResNet.
- Wireless access is available throughout all academic buildings via the WU-Student network.
